





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Proceeding of the state level Kharif planning workshop for 2018-19 for Special Programme for Promotion of Millets in Tribal Areas" (Odisha Millets Mission) held on 5th& 6th April 2018 at Conference Hall, IMAGE Bhubaneswar

State level Kharif planning workshop for 2018-19 of "Special programme for promotion of Millets in tribal areas of Odisha" (Odisha Millets Mission) held on 5th& 6th April 2018 at Conference Hall, IMAGE Bhubaneswar.

Following are the objectives of the meeting:

1. GP wise, Cluster wise and Block wise Kharif production planning and Capacity building strategy for 2018-19.
2. GP Wise, Cluster wise and Block Wise strategy for introduction of millet in ICDS and MDM.
3. Process of online submission of SoEs /Reports/UCs for Odisha Millets Mission(OMM).

At the outset, Shri M Muthukumar IAS, Director, Agriculture & Food Production (A & FP), Odisha welcomed the participants.

First session was chaired by Shri BhaskarJyoti Sarma IAS, Special Secretary, Agriculture & Farmers Empowerment Department, Government of Odisha. He said, Odisha Millets Mission (OMM) should focus on developing institutional framework for increasing income of farmers through better marketing of the surplus. At least 80% of the market price should reach to farmers. Rigorous baseline and evaluation should be undertaken by NCDS, Bhubaneswar to understand improvements of the intervention.

Dr Srijit Mishra, Director, NCDS, Bhubaneswar spoke about expectations and overview of the sessions of the workshop. He stressed on the need to ensure that local crop systems are chosen based on the farmer's preference. Any specific millet crop should not be imposed, instead improved agronomic practices in locally preferred cropping systems should be promoted.

Director of A & FP asked participants to come up with a structure for Project Management unit (PMU) at state and district level. This PMU will look into special schemes for rainfed areas such as Odisha Millet Mission and PKVY.

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After the address by Director, A &FP, Odisha, Participants were divided into district wise groups. Each district was tasked with development of strategy, listing of issues and solutions on following subjects to ensure effective implementation of OMM for FY 2018-19.

1. GP wise Block wise Kharif production planning strategy for FY 2018-19.
2. GP wise Block wise capacity building/campaign for farmer mobilisation/setting up of processing units for FY 2018-19.

ATMA Officials, FA representatives & State Secretariat representatives of each district brainstormed on the above subjects:-

Based on the deliberations, scheme officer of each district made a presentation.

1. Tentative Millet Crop Coverage target for FY 2018-19 is 11622.36 Hectares in 29 blocks.
2. Total additional seed supply requirement is estimated at 192 quintals

Concluding session of the state level Kharif planning workshop for FY 2018-19 was chaired by Dr Saurabh Garg IAS, Principal Secretary, Agriculture & Farmers Empowerment, Government of Odisha. Other Panelists were Director, A & F P, Odisha and Director, NCDS.

A summary presentation based on the deliberations was made by Mr Dinesh Balam, State Co ordinator of Programme Secretariat, Odisha Millets Mission.

Following were the decisions made in the concluding session:

1. Efforts will be made to procure quality seeds from farmers within block/district/state. If needed, local seeds shall be procured by ATMA as per the prevailing market price after germination test.
2. Programme Secretariat will facilitate the millet seed exchange between clusters/GP/blocks/ districts.
3. To meet the further demand, Millet Seeds (Breeder /Foundation/ Certified/ Truthfully Labelled) will be procured by PD, ATMA and facilitated by Directorate of Agriculture and Food Production from ICAR/OUAT/ICRISAT/Agriculture Research stations/SAUs/ private agencies. A detail seed plan will be developed by PD, ATMA .
4. The incentives on Improved agronomic practices will be given to the same beneficiary for the next 3 years in a reduced manner. The Directorate of Agriculture and Food Production will share the year wise incentives.

5. Simplified draft financial guidelines with protocol will be prepared by the Programme Secretariat based on the deliberations of the Kharif planning workshop. It will be circulated for feedback of FAs , ATMAs, and D.A & F.P. Final version with feedback from stakeholders shall be submitted to Dept of A & F.E. for approval.
6. Revised guidelines with amendments/changes as per the need shall be prepared by State Secretariat (NCDS & WASSAN) in consultation with D.A & F.P (O) for approval by dept of A & F E.
7. An uniform training and capacity building protocol be prepared by the D.A & F.P (O).
8. A draft proposal for setting of PMU at State and District Level along with the financial implications will be submitted by State Secretariat before 20th April 2018 for approval of A & F.E dept.
9. FAs are allowed to extend the area of operations to nearby GPs in the neighbouring non programme blocks of Odisha Millet Mission within district to achieve the targetted area without any additional remuneration. ATMA/Programme Secretariat is directed to provide necessary support.
10. Screening of CRPs / FA staffs will be done by ATMA & Programme Secretariat to ensure the quality of the work.
11. Deputy Director Agriculture cum PD, ATMA will ensure immediate release of pending funds to CBOs and FAs who have submitted proper bills and vouchers. Pending TA & DA incurred by Scheme officers/AAOs on monitoring of this special programme will have to be cleared by DDAs from the funds available under ATMA / T.E of Dist. and Range administration within a week of submission of bills & vouchers by concerned officials.
12. All the officers (DAO/DPD/SMS/ AAO / BTM/ BLTA / VAW/ Krushak Sathi) in the programme areas and ministerial staffs must be involved for success of this Special Programme and any dereliction will be viewed seriously.
13. Millets will be supplied in ICDS and MDM as supplement but not as replacement.
14. Pilots in inclusion of millets in ICDS/MDM shall be conducted by State Secretariat (NCDS &WASSAN) in 7 programme districts.
